WHAT IS A TIP VOLUNTEER?

TIP volunteers are called by law enforcement, fire, medical and hospital personnel to respond to scenes of sudden or unexpected death (natural, homicide, suicide, accidental, infant) industrial accidents, sexual assaults, overdoses, violent crime and other traumatic incidents to provide immediate emotional and practical support to families, friends, witnesses and survivors.



WHERE DOES TIP RESPOND?

TIP of Greater Portland volunteers are dispatched through the 911 system or hospital ER staff in the communities of Portland, South Portland, Westbrook, Scarborough, Falmouth, Gorham, Windham and Cumberland.

WHAT IS REQUIRED FOR ME TO BE A TIP VOLUNTEER?

- ♥ Successful completion of ALL Training Dates
- ♥ Fingerprint & Background Check through TIP
- ♥ Valid Driver's License and Vehicle
- ♥ Clean Driving Record
- ♥ Proof of Auto Insurance
- ♥ Proof of Covid Vaccination
- ♥ Cell Phone (with texting)
- ♥ Internet and Email Access
- ♥ Three 12-hour shifts per month
- ♥ Attend Mandatory Continuing Education Meeting on the 2nd Tuesday of each month
